Meanwhile 3.6 billion people do not have **HEALTH COVERAGE**.




Meanwile 1.4 billion adults are UNEMPLOYED.

YES, because you encourage the growth of criminal finance by reducing taxes on wealth and legitimise tax evasion, which steals \$685 billion a year from the world community! By not outlawing tax havens, you are guilty of not helping 3.6 billion people without health protection, of forsaking 2.1 billion people without access to clean water and 4.2 billion people without sanitation; of not helping impoverished workers because their wages no longer allow them to live in dignity.
